

# SUBMISSION GUIDELINES — please note changes this year

- Films can be no longer than 10 minutes in length. (Shorter is better, per our judges!) Categories may include documentary, experimental, narrative, music video, animation, public service announcement, and incorporate drama, comedy, fantasy, etc. on any topic of your choice. A special award, "The Moxy," is given for the best entry using a dog theme. All other awards are deemed by our judges and may vary each year.
- It is recommended that subject matter and presentation be appropriate for grades 8-12. Use of non-copyrighted and/or original music is highly encouraged by the judges as selected films in compliance will be uploaded to a variety of websites. Entrants assume all liability with regard to copyrights, and agree to permit broadcast of their entries using any means deemed by FilmDayton.
- Each entry is to be on a separate, labeled DVD that is playable on standard equipment and/or computer. Send 2 (two) DVDs copies of each entry. Please check your entry before sending, and write the accurate run time on the DVD as well as the entry form. Entry forms may be obtained at www.filmdayton.org and are to be attached to each submission. There is an entry fee of \$5 per film. Make checks payable to FilmDayton. **Submission Limit**: 1 (one) collaboratively produced and/or 1 (one) individually produced film per student.
